"Japan in 2013" will focus on prospects for Japan over the next year in both the domestic and international arenas. Keynote speakers include Dr. Gerald L. Curtis of Columbia University (domestic prospects) and Japanese foreign policy commentator Yukio Okamoto (international). The one-day symposium will feature two panel discussions, a networking luncheon and reception, and a significant opportunity for comments from the floor.
